- School Good News:

g. Students doing stations of the cross and focused on lent.
h. Reading themes, presentations, assemblies well received by students.
i. Kindergarten is starting to focus on readings books and using iPads.
j. Kids really enjoyed the DJ for the middle-school dance.
- Principals Report:
a. Getting towards end of virtual Spanish program. Structure was not ideal. Working with a potential teaching candidate to start in the fall of 2022, possibly sooner.
b. Working on verifying staffing for 2022-2023 school year.
c. Parent group meeting on Friday, $3 / 11$ to work on next steps with the greenhouse.
d. $8^{\text {th }}$ grade retreat was held at Camp Vista on February $25^{\text {th }}$. Potentially looking to do school mass there before end of school year.
e. Re-Enrollment season has begun. (16 re-enrolls, 2 new preschool siblings so far)
i. Little Lambs program showed potential for 4-7 new children
f. Potential counseling candidate not as interested as initially thought. Coordinating with CSD/St. Matt's for consulting.
