School Reports-Ron Smyczek (Mrs. Goffard, Mrs. Hughes)

- School Good News:
a. The academic theme of The Lord is our Shepherd is going well, the plan for next year will be discussed at June in-service. Submit ideas!
b. Stations during Lent went well.
c. The kids' peanut butter and jelly drive had a positive outcome.
d. Muffins with Mom has found a great rhythm.
e. Bake Sale raised $\$ 850$ in sales. Big thanks for organizing. This money goes towards Spanish materials for the library, ie. flash cards, familiar books, etc.
f. First Communion was a couple weeks ago, and it went well. May crowning is tomorrow $5 / 3$.
g. We have 9 eighth graders on course to graduate. All going to SMSA
h. GOTR practice 5 k is tomorrow $5 / 3$ at SOTH and the event is $5 / 13$ at Fondy HS. It has been a very positive experience for the girls. We have 9 girls in the $3-5^{\text {th }}$ grade. Hope is to have this continue at SOTH and try and get the 6-8 grades involved.
i. Need ideas on how to add in programs next year like the GOTR? Ex: Walking with a purpose program is one that information is going out in the newsletter. More ideas welcomed.


## - Principals Report:

a. New Superintendent at Archdiocese, Ed Foy. Not sure if there will be any changes.
b. Safety plan review with Fondly Sheriff to continue programs. Some minor safety issues were noted, and plans are in place to fix.
c. State funds proposal for budget to send money to private/religious schools. Advocacy groups working on a proposed plan for this money, similar to how the COVID money was divided.
d. Held Love and Logic series, which helps build relationships and puts ownership to students and not teachers, etc. Low attendance to this. There are videos available to view at request.
e. Enrollment: 80 students eligible and currently 50 are re-enrolled. We know of a few students not returning. We have had lots of tours and are building the little lambs program. We are not able to advertise in the mail due to crossing other school boundaries. Word of mouth is our best method. The idea of advertising in day cares was discussed and it sounded like this may be an outlet we can use without crossing other schools.
f. Staffing: Mrs. Goffard will be assisting in the 3k room next year, Mrs. Diane is retiring, Miss Johnson is stepping down to attend Grad School, Mrs. Baus will be done to pursue her other career, and our science teacher will not be returning next year.
g. We are in the process of hiring a $3^{\text {rd }}$ grade teacher-Amelia. A couple of local parishioners Sue and Carla are going to tag team the childcare. Dan Z agreed to take driving position but only part time, Still working on details of how this will work. Looking for someone else to cover the other half of this job.
h. Needs: Kindergarten, Science, $4^{\text {th }}$ grade teachers needed. Along with bus driver.
i. Discussion on the 3 and $4^{\text {th }}$ grade splitting due to $4^{\text {th }}$ graders moving up to middle school, are the current $3^{\text {rd }}$ graders ready for middle school? With the smaller numbers will this work? Also, in a similar issue with the 6 and $7^{\text {th }}$ graders split for next year? Continue splitting for certain classes?
j. Mr. Smyczek is leaving at the end of the year. Evaluating options for this role.
