School Reports - Ron Smyczek (Brittany Bengel, Karen Kutka)

- School Good News:
  - a. 6 students in grades 2-3 received First Communion
  - b. We won 6 out of 8 Knights of Columbus math and spelling quizzes
  - c. Positive reviews on Lock-In and Music Lunch with teachers from dinner auction
  - d. Many lenten activities and reflections incorporate to remind students and families of the importance of our faith
  - e. \$20,000 grant received to help offset 3% increase in tuition
  - f. COVID funds must be planned by May 13 with ability to spend by fall 2023 (used for technology, cleaning supplies, virtual Spanish program, and internet)
  - g. Teacher Appreciation Week: Theme is Peace, Love, and Teaching
  - h. Preparing for painting of the building this summer with FUNDA funds
  - i. Middle School (grades 6-8) will be attending Track & Field event in Sheboygan

- j. Middle School Science Update:
  - i. 8<sup>th</sup> graders finished electricity and circuits labs where they created light-up greeting cards, now working on dissection and anatomy
  - ii. 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> working on food science
  - iii. 5<sup>th</sup> graders working on waves and light labs

# • Principals Report:

- a. Virtual Spanish program ended in March, but have Senora Torres with us in-person to finish out school year and signed on for next year
- b. Greenhouse is up and running. Using for class learning: observation, measurement, and process. Plants also being used for art projects, Fond du Lac Museum, and SoTH garden.
- c. Many May Events:
  - i. May 4: Grandparents Day and May Crowning
  - ii. May 5: Kindergarten Testing
  - iii. May 11: Muffins with Mom
  - iv. May 18: Camp Vista Mass, Candle Ceremony, Field Day

- d. Re-enrollment: 71 of 81 re-enrolled. 2 not returning. 2 verbal re-enroll. 5 uncommitted. 6 new students (5 in 3K/4K), 1 from Little Lambs so far.

  - i. Fall conferences will be in-person with students attending
  - ii. Encourage a focus on families taking vacation days around breaks instead of sporadically
  - iii. 3 Wellness Days (October, February, April) with no in-person school gathering
    - 1. Student activities with help of Home & School: service, nature, roller skating, mental health and reflection, etc.
    - 2. Teachers focus on some planning and especially mental health
